Cut all orange marked trees. Cut all hardwoods (except oak and cherry), and aspen (designated) containing 1 or more 100-inch pulpsticks. Retain all oak, cherry and conifers except for marked spruce. Every 5<sup>th</sup> row of this plantation has all trees painted with vertical orange marks providing minimum 10-ft wide logging access lanes. Utilize hardwood sawlogs to a 10-inch minimum DIB top and pulpwood to a 4-inch minimum DOB top.

#### GENERAL SALE OPERATIONAL SPECIFICATIONS

No logging during April, May or June. New roads must be pre-approved by the sale administrator.
