Course Description:

This updated for 2017, **Non-Language Specific** three (3) CIMCE credit hour course will outline and familiarize the Student with "**Non-Ballistic**" (Clubs, Knifes, Hand-Held) weapons and tools used in the commission of crimes. It will outline the history and evolution of weapons and how they are being utilized by today's criminal element as well as weapons and equipment utilized by current law enforcement professionals. Students will learn the diverse types of weapons used in custody environments as well as typical weapons used on the streets by criminal gang members and other law offenders. Current terminology and nomenclature will be emphasized as part of this dynamic three-hour course, along with basic overviews of how weapons work, and the seemingly harmless household items used to make them.

Instructor:

Jeff Torres is currently a full time Law Enforcement Professional with over 20 years of Law enforcement experience. His vast experience in many high-level felony investigations include, Homicide, Robbery, Narcotics, Sexual Assault and Death Investigation to name a few. Mr. Torres is currently a law enforcement supervisor and brings to the classroom current, and expert knowledge of weapons used by individuals involved in gang violence, narcotic violence and general criminal activity. Mr. Torres is certified by the **California State Commission on Peace Officer Standards and Training** and currently possesses Basic, Intermediate, Advanced and Supervisory Certification which is issued to Peace Officers who have attained defined levels of academic education, law enforcement training, supervisory experience, and years of service in the law enforcement profession. Mr. Torres has extensive public presentation experience, and has conducted numerous training sessions with associated professional and interpreter groups. The information contained in this course will be presented through interactive lecture, electronic presentation, hand-out literature and "hands-on" training and familiarization with non-ballistic weapons and associated tools.
