The Truth to Abiding

***Truth** – the quality or state of being true, that which is true or in accordance with fact or reality, a fact or belief that is accepted as true.

*Truth-ale`theia(al-ay`-thi-a) truth of idea, reality, divine truth revealed to man, straightforwardness.

***John 14:6 (NASB)** “Jesus said to him, “I am the way, and the truth, and the life; no one comes to the Father but through Me.”

***John 16:13(NASB)** “But when He, the Spirit of truth comes, He will guide you into all truth; For He will not speak on His own initiative, but whatever He hears, He will speak; and He will disclose to you what is to come.”

***John 8:32(ESV)** “And you will know the truth, and the truth will set you free.”

***Psalm 25:5(NASB)** “Lead me in Your truth and teach me, For You are the God of my salvation; For You I wait all the day.”

***Isaiah 54:13(NASB)** “All your sons will be taught of the LORD; And the well-being(peace) of your sons will be great.”

***Jeremiah 6:16(NASB)** “Thus says the LORD, “Stand by the ways and see and ask for the ancient paths, Where the good way is, and walk in it; And you will find rest for your souls....””

WHY IMPORTANT

***John 4:16-18(NASB)** “He said to her, “Go, call your husband and come here.” 17 The woman answered and said, “I have no husband.” Jesus said to her, “You have correctly said, ‘I have no husband’; 18.....and the one you now have is not your husband; this you have said truly(true in fact, truthful).”

*Abide – be unable to tolerate (someone/something), to remain stable or fixed in a state, to wait (Psalm 25:5 “For You I wait all the day), to continue in a place.

*Similar words – last, tarry, stay, persist, endure(continuing firm or resolute through trials and difficulties).

***John 15:4-5(NASB)** “Abide in Me, and I in you. As the branch cannot bear fruit of itself unless it abides in the vine, so neither [can] you unless you abide in Me. 5 I am the vine, you are the branches; he who abides in Me and I in him, he bears much fruit, for apart from Me you can do nothing.”

***Psalm 91:1** “He who dwells in the shelter of the Most High will abide in the shadow of the Almighty.”

***1 John 2:24** “As for you, let that abide in you which you heard from the beginning. If what you heard from the beginning abides in you, you also will abide in the Son and in the Father.”

***1 John 4:16** “...God is love, and the one who abides in love abides in God, and God abides in him.”

***1 Corinthians 13:13** “But now faith, hope, love abide these three; but the greatest of these is love.”
