

## **TOCO Family Festival Frequently Asked Questions:**

### **Q: Are there parking fees?**

A: Yes, there is a \$5 parking fee if you do not have a lodging accommodation. Each lodging accommodation has room for one parking spot next to the accommodation. The exception to this are the field and forest camping spots, which will have to drop off their gear and park in the parking lot.

### **Q: What makes TOCO different from other music festivals?**

A: Our family focus sets us apart. As the very first, and flagship fundraising summertime event of Tapestry of Community Offerings, TOCO Family Festival is unique in that it simultaneously serves as both fundraiser and mission driven event. While the family camp out creates a place help develop financial support for TOCO's year round community outreach, it also exemplifies the TOCO mission to empower children and families through green and community partnerships. Over 25 diverse musical acts spanning every genre share their talents with festival families, and many of the acts are composed of performances by different generations of family members. The event also offers multiple quality family focused educational activities that foster togetherness. Recycled birdhouses making, parent-child music lessons, recycled paper and journal making, energy efficiency classes, astronomy investigations, and seed-planting and sharing are a few favorite family workshops. **Q: What are the hours of the festival?**

A: Doors open at 3:00 pm Friday, August 25th & close at 11:00 am Sunday, August 27th. The majority of activities wrap up Saturday night.

**Q: Can we camp on Thursday?**

A: Absolutely! Jellystone Park welcomes TOCO campers who want to stay prior to the TOCO event which starts on Friday, August 25th, 2017 at 3:00 pm. To book a stay any night other than during the TOCO Festival on Friday, August 25th or Saturday, August 26th, 2017, please contact Jellystone Park directly at 636-938-5925. Mention that you will be attending TOCO and receive a 20% DISCOUNT off your stay any of these nights: August 23rd or August 24th before the festival or August 27th, 28th, 29th, 2017 after the festival. **Q: Are pets allowed?**

A: Pets will be admitted with a \$15 donation per pet and may be added as a "General Admission Tickets" option on the TICKETS page. Animals must be leashed & controlled (including waste pick-up). Upon arrival please bring dogs for check-in. THERE IS A PET PARADE ON SATURDAY! NO ANIMALS WILL BE ADMITTED OR ALLOWED TO STAY WITHOUT CONSENT TO ABOVE CONDITIONS.

**Q: Are there any chances for discounts on admission?**

**Q: We only want to camp for one night. How much does that cost?**

A: Field camping is \$10 per person, and you can camp for one night, or for the weekend. All other campsites are rented for the ENTIRE WEEKEND, and General Admission Tickets are additional. Children 12 and under are free. Visit our TICKETS page.

**Q: What is included with admission to the festival?**

A: General Admission includes all the amenities that Jellystone & TOCO Festival have to offer: Costume & Campsite Decorating Contests, Diverse Music, Swimming, Mini-Golf(small fee), Hikes, Volleyball, TOCO Kids' Club & Workshops, Food & Art Vendors & More!

**Q: Is TOCO Family Festival ADA accessible?**

**Q: Are there quiet hours, and is there a curfew?**

A: Children under 18 years of age must be accompanied by an adult in accordance with local curfew laws (11pm-6am). Quiet hours begin at 2:00 am ONLY during Festival (August 25<sup>th</sup> and 26<sup>th</sup>). During normal Jellystone stays the Quiet Hours begin at 10:00 pm!
