Thank you to everyone who graciously purchased items from the Scouts last Sunday!



At 9:00am, we gather for Morning Prayer in the Chapel (and sometimes go out to breakfast right after).


At 11:30am, we make lunches for PADS, the homeless people in Lake County.


Book Club
