- Liaison with inspection staff from the municipality in which the projects are located.
- Preparation of daily progress reports and regular reporting to the client and senior staff.
- Coordination of regular project meetings during the construction phase.
- Quantity take-off and preparation of monthly progress payment quantities for all contracts relating to the projects.
- Coordination with the Clients as it falls within your scope of work, to ensure the Client's needs are fulfilled.
- Engineering coordination in support of construction projects.
- Topographical surveys, subdivision construction layout, and other Geomatic work. Carry equipment and supplies and install stakes. Assisting survey chief as required.
- Other tasks as required.

- 1 to 3 years of experience in the field of inspection of municipal and land development projects.
- An understanding of underground utility and road construction materials, methods, and processes.

- Knowledge of As-Built preparation and specifications.
