DESCRIPTION: This is a nice Herter's bow that has been partially refinished. Someone had epoxied a steel dowel into the riser as a rest. It was sawed off flush and stained. Brazilian Rosewood riser. Bow has no delamination; no cracks; limbs are straight. Beveled arrow shelf. Overlays and tips are in great condition. No drilled holes; No chips, dings or cracks. No stress lines or crazing. A few minor scratches and nicks here and there. Someone had used acetone to clean the limb which wiped off the decal specs, so a sticker was added in its place. This bow does not have string grooves, so it is important to assure that the string is centered in the middles of the limbs to prevent the limb from twisting. Overall, this is a really nice bow in excellent condition for its age.

Note: The limbs are both white, although one looks a bit bluish in the pic.
