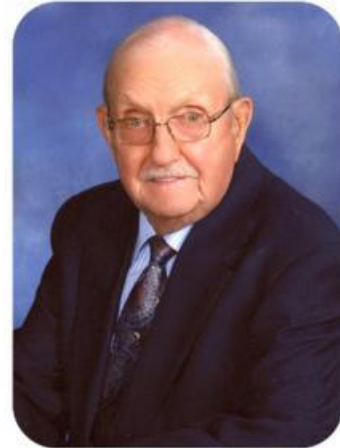


Joseph John Hudo

Mr. Joseph J. Hudo, 88 of Rapson and formerly of Tempe, Ariz. Passed away on Monday, June 2, 2014 at McLaren Bay Regional Medical Center in Bay City after a short illness.
