NEW PRODUCTS for 1970

The new X10 Professional leads the parade of new designs in the laminated bow line. The new Pro sight and short-draw length of 64", plus triple overlays on the face and back are only half the story. The "Pro" is followed closely by the all-new X15 Titan and the X16 Supreme for a well rounded choice of lengths and price ranges of top tournament bows. See pages 12 and 13 for more on these beauties.

The ever popular Kaibab (X27) and Ocala (X17) have new dressing, but the fantastic speed and smoothness for which they are noted has not been tampered with. A welcome addition to the family is the all new Ocala Special — the first hunting bow built specially for the sight-shooting bowhunters. More details on pages 4 and 5.

The Custer (X22) has been changed from 62" to 64" and is considered the best school and beginner's bow on the market. See it on page 10.

Such standbys as the Necedah, Super Necedah, Tioga, Manitou and Yukon are still the best values in their price ranges. And Ernie Root (one of the outstanding bowyers in the industry — and general manager of our production facilities) really outdid himself with the Cascade! The combination of limb configuration and width allows us to build a short bow that not only looks fast, but is fast. An engineering marvel far ahead of its time in the industry!

The Shakespeare rotary Hunter broadhead quiver holds eight big game arrows quietly and safely at your side where they are ready instantly. This eliminates the unbalancing effort of bow quiver and allows you to get full power out of your bow.

The new Hunter sight has a slide bar that detaches from the base for easy transportation, yet the sight has all windage and yardage adjustments.

The all new Mark IV broadhead has the necessary features of replacement of *both* the primary and auxiliary blades, and they are sharp. Also note the new quick-draw holster side quiver and a new offering of the D223 with velcro fasteners. An attractive Shakespeare arm patch is also available this year.

The Thunderbolt! This arrow will be heard from throughout the archery industry this year, and will probably take more game than any other single arrow in years to come. See page 14 for the details on this all-new concept in big game hunting.

An engineering first! The Cascade has 2½" wide limbs — a full ½" wider than other hunting bows. This extra width distributes the stress over a wider area which, for the first time, allows a limb design of a bow 14" larger. This means more speed (up to 33⅓% faster) less stack and smoother draw than any other bow of this length. The Cascade is built of jet-age material with a black formica handle riser and special black fiberglass face and back. This 50" black beauty also has the new Shakespeare Hunter arrow rest and comes with the String Ease bow stringer, an "ABC's of Archery" booklet, and a subscription to Archery World magazine.

Face and back are black glass with black and white overlays in the riser section. Nock overlay is benge and zebra in a three layer laminate. Perfectly stabilized. A field tester in the big buck country of Arizona tagged this bow with its name. 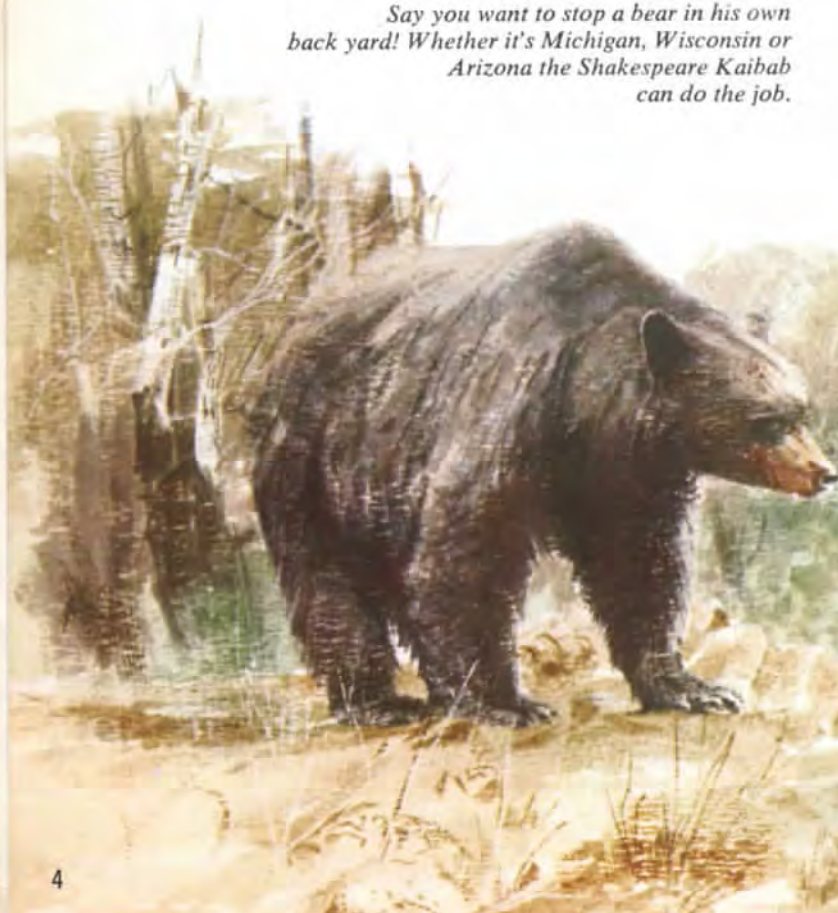

The A70 grade arrows are designed for the beginning bow hunter on a low budget. Select Port Orford cedar is used in these arrows and they are all matched for bows from 40 lbs. to 50 lbs. The hunting arrows are camouflaged yet have bright yellow spray crest for visibility and have a 5" fletch. The target arrows have a 3½" fletch. A70 arrows come in dozen pack and in 30" and 31" AMO Standard lengths. These are for 29" and 30" draw lengths.

Add $\frac{1}{4}$ -inch to the length shown on the yardstick for arrow length.



For proper length, arrow should reach from chest beyond extended fingertips.
