## **NvFRW Votes to Support Commerce Tax Repeal**

### ***Republican Women Urged to Gather Signatures***

Las Vegas, NV — April 28, 2016 — At its 2016 Spring Board meeting in Las Vegas, Nevada, the board of directors of the Nevada Federation of Republican Woman (NvFRW) voted to support Nevada Controller Ron Knecht's petition to place a referendum on the November 2016 ballot to either approve or repeal the commerce tax.

"Voters rejected Question 3, a gross receipts tax in the ballot box, by 80 percent, and we were surprised when our elected legislators and governor went against our wishes to pass the Commerce Tax," said Lori Piotrowski, president of the Nevada Federation of Republican Women. "This is the largest tax increase in Nevada's history, passed at a time when our economy is still suffering. As Republicans, we support a fiscally sound government, but one that also abides by the wishes of its electorate."
