Registration/ Timeline:

- On-line Registration is open.
- Lakes goes OFF-LIMITS on 22 January 2023 at midnight.

Caution,

Lake Belton is currently 13.75 feet low. Extreme caution must be used on the lake.

Saturday 28 January 2023:

Tournament Day – Day 1

- Check-in and Boat Number draw begins at 6:00am, at the ramp at Cedar Ridge Park.
 - a) For safety reasons and to comply with the Youth Sports Safety Act, all boats must have 3 persons, 2 student anglers and a Boat Captain. If for whatever reason an angler cannot make it that team must provide an observer.
 - b) This will not be a trailering event.
- The Official Launch site will be Cedar Ridge Park.
- The Official Launch Time is Safe Light.

You may put in beginning at 5:30am. Boats will be launched in numbered order beginning at safe-light.

 - a) All Boat Captains need to be mine full of the “No-Wake Zones” and be sure you are not cutting off other anglers as you leave the ramp area.
 - b) All Boat Captains must observe any, and all posted “No Fishing Areas” / “No Boat Areas”
- The Official weigh-in site will be Cedar Ridge Park.
- The Scales will open at 2:00pm.
- The Scales will close at 2:30pm. Anglers must be in line by 2:30pm with their catch.
 - a) Anglers and Boat Captains that do not come to the weigh-in site must text 254-368-0294 once they are off the water.
