
188 DAY EARTHQUAKE CYCLE

This chart and information presented is not intended to predict a date/time for a significant earthquake but to bring attention to a the relationship between the 188 day count pattern of earthquakes along the Pacific 'Ring of Fire' since 2010 that correlate to certain celestial alignments. The 188 day count also correlates to the Solstices of the Earth's rotation. This study shows the 188 Day Earthquake Cycle that started with the Conception Chile earthquake of Feb 27, 2010. When 188 days are added, end date excluded and 1 day adjustment for time change, for the subsequent date corresponds to the Christchurch and Sendai earthquake dates. Interestingly, all of the distances are within 500 miles of each other. Moreover, either a New or Full Moon occurred within days of each event earthquake during the cycle. Perhaps such a 188 day count could lead to significant earthquake predictions. The study also catalogs the dramatic increase in various trends related to natural disasters; volcanoes, earthquakes, and disasters, etc.
