- Sonja Blodgett joined the meeting with concerns on town meeting setup, Road Commissioner questions, and Sherrif not being on the warning. Here is the summary of the discussion outcome:
- **Meeting Setup for Town Meeting Day**:
 - Discussion about logistics for the upcoming Town Meeting Day, including the arrangement of bleachers and tables at the school.
 - The need for a designated area for children's activities and food provisions was mentioned, with plans for adult supervision.
- Job Descriptions and Road Commissioner Role**:
 - Review of job descriptions for the Road Commissioner position, including responsibilities and qualifications.
 - Discussion on whether the Road Commissioner should be elected or appointed, with emphasis on the need for oversight and accountability.
 - -Role Clarity: There is a clear need for defined roles and responsibilities, particularly concerning the Road Commissioner position, to ensure accountability and effective governance.
- ** Sheriff's department not on Warning **
 - -The answer of why the Sheriff's department was not a part of the warning is that the Sheriff's department did not put in a request to be on the warning for this year. The Town would have needed to have this request 40 days before town meeting to have been included. Other people in the meeting

raised concerns about the effectiveness of the sheriff's department and community perceptions regarding their performance.
