

Too Much Airplane Noise?

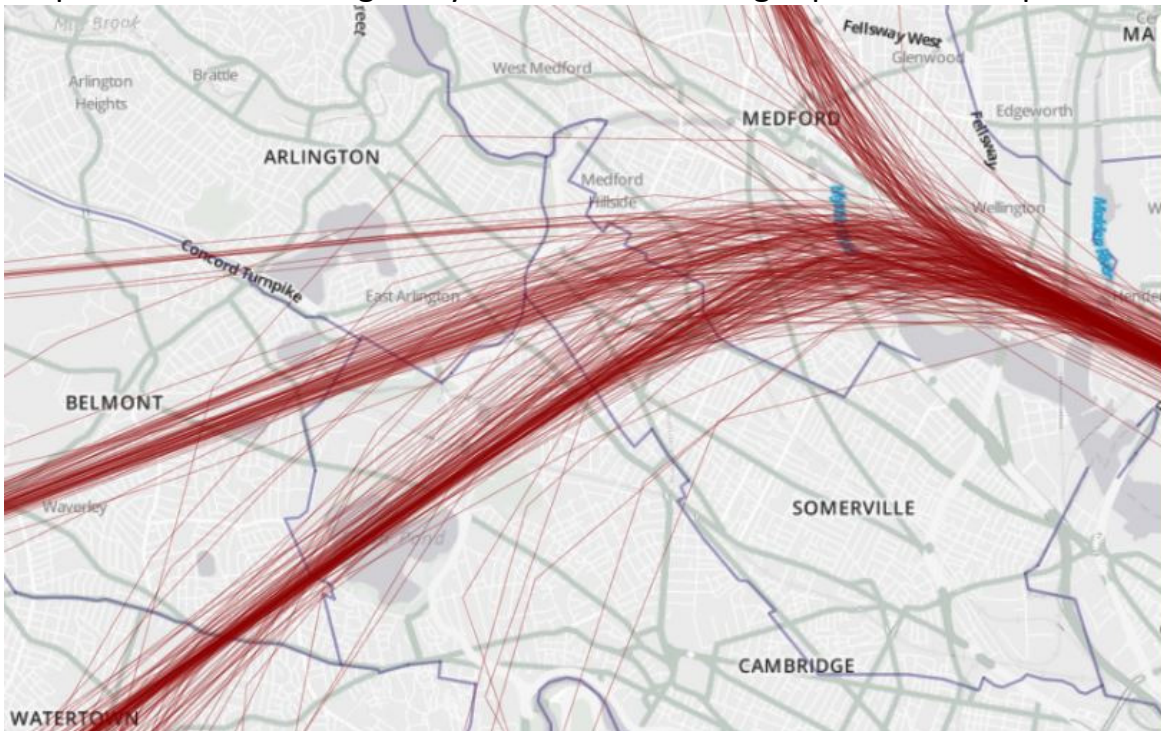
