The Port Authority Police Department Pipes and Drums has a rich history since its conception in 1979. The band has had the distinct honor of representing the department in many capacities, performed for dignitaries, and has been the host band for Police Week in our Washington DC.

On September 11, 2001, America faced its darkest day when terrorists attacked the World Trade Center and Pentagon with 3 passenger planes, and a fourth plane crashed in a field in Shanksville, Pennsylvania. The Port Authority lost 37 members of the department that day, and three of those officers were members of this band. Police Officers Liam Callahan, Steve Huczko and Richie Rodriguez were on duty and responded to the World Trade Center to assist in the evacuation and rescue of thousands of people inside the two towers. Tragically, they were inside the buildings when they collapsed.

Through this Memorial Scholarship fund, the band continues to honor their selfless acts and provide educational assistance for a student with a musical background to follow a similar career path.

SCHOLARSHIP APPLICATION INSTRUCTIONS AND PROCESS

Information and applications are available through the Port Authority Police Pipes and Drums website at www.PAPDPipeBand.com and must be received by the Scholarship Committee no later than May 1, 2024.

Extensions will not be granted. Applications that are incomplete or received after the deadline will not be considered. Letters of recommendation should be mailed with the application, if possible, but must be received by the deadline.

The selection of the recipient is at the sole discretion of the Scholarship Committee.

The criteria used to select the recipient shall be related to the purpose of the grant, and may include (but are not limited to) the following:

- Prior academic performance and course of future study
 - Participation in an organized pipe band
 - Recommendation letter from music instructor or band director
 - Resident of New York or New Jersey
 - Graduating high school senior or entering college freshman
- All educational grants shall be awarded using an objective and nondiscriminatory selection process approved by the Committee in advance of making awards. Recipient will be notified in April and a presentation of the award will be made sometime in May/June.
