

# **ROSE EVA MITIN**

## **1917 - 1995**

Rose Eva Mitin, 78 of Midland, formerly of Sebawaing, died Sunday, Nov. 20 at Tendercare Nursing Home, Midland, after a brief stay.

She was born Jan. 25, 1917, on Section Line Road, Harbor Beach, the daughter of John and Mary (Garstenschlager) Kain. She was baptized in April, 1917, at Zion Lutheran Church, Harbor Beach, and confirmed at New Salem Lutheran Church, Sebawaing.

She was graduated from Sebawaing High School in June, 1935, as class valedictorian. She was recipient of the American Legion Citizen School Award from Stammitz-Lindeman Post 292.

She was married to Alex Mitin of Bay Port on Dec. 25, 1943, at New Salem Church, Sebawaing, and they lived on a farm near Pigeon until his death on Dec. 19, 1972. She then moved to Midland and was a member of Good Shepherd Lutheran Church, Midland.

She was a past member of the New Salem Church choir, a Sunday School teacher at St. John's Lutheran Church, Pigeon, a member of Huron and Midland County Farm Bureaus, and a volunteer for Pigeon/Winsor Township United Fund drives.

Surviving are two sons, Harry (Betty) Mitin and Timothy Mitin, all of Midland, two grandchildren, Jeffrey and Jill Mitin, two half-sisters, Esther (Louis) Bauer of Bayard, NB, and Florence (Henry) Moyer of Broomfield, CO, and many nieces and nephews.

A memorial service for Mrs. Mitin was held at Good Shepherd Church, Midland, Saturday, Nov. 25, with Pastor J. Otto and Pastor J. Seifert officiating.
