A Word from Pastor Jenni

Dear Friends, I bring you this message from the Anti-Racism Steering Committee.

"Instead, renew the thinking in your mind by the Spirit and clothe yourself with the new person created according to God's image in justice and true holiness." Ephesians 4:23,24 *CEB*

At the Vestry meeting in June, the following resolution was passed unanimously:

Background: Many in our parish are grieved that recent events and especially the murder of George Floyd have revealed once again the evil of racism in our country.

We have proclaimed that the Church of the Annunciation is a place of Inclusion, Honesty, Empowerment, Challenge and Hope.

Our Baptismal Covenant calls us to "seek and serve Christ in all persons, loving our neighbor as ourselves"

and to "strive for justice and peace among all people, and respect the dignity of every human being"

We resolve to raise up a group of leaders in the parish to steer us in the following: Learn more about systemic racism and its insidious impact in areas of all our lives. Connect us with individuals and groups in our community who have been affected by racism and who have power to make change. Act to be a visible force in ending racism in our community and country.

This week, the Anti Racism Steering Committee met for the first time. Alli Crain, Deb Modde, Maria Westphal, Rev. Jane Schaefer, Jen Edwards, Pastor Jenni and I may have been seated at a safe distance from each other, but we were drawn together by our shared passion and commitment to ending the sin of racism in our community. This is a group that will not be satisfied by tame or incremental change that is limited by how comfortable we feel. We are called to significant, impactful, and even sometimes uncomfortable learning, connection and action that will make a difference for people of color right now. We fully believe that Black Lives Matter.

We spent most of our first meeting telling our own stories, listening to each other and brainstorming ideas for learning, connecting and acting. We are anxious to share a plan with you soon so that the whole parish can get involved in this important work in whatever capacity you can. I will miss being with you all on Sunday ... even on Zoom! It is truly one of the highlights of my week.






Eventbrite Invitation for Sunday 7/5




Donations for PADS
