The Board of Trustees met for a special meeting at 5:00 p.m. on April 21, 2026 at the McNabb Public Library. The purpose of this meeting was to discuss the drainage issues that have occurred in the last week throughout the village.

In attendance was Village President Edens, Clerk Harrison, Trustees Baker, J, Campbell, R. Campbell, Cimei, Raiter, and Trone. Also in attendance was Bruce Harrison to explain to the board the findings as of this time.

The first issue is in the subdivision at the corner of Walter Avenue and 2nd Street.

There was water standing in the corner of the lot and after investigating it was decided that the saddle needed to be replaced on the 2" water line running to the D. Edens residence.

Also discovered was that the tile running across the lot is either plugged or broken. The fact that the property owner drives into the lot with no culvert or driveway is contributing to the breaking of the tile. Will ask Haar to check zoning ordinance on the stipulations for a required driveway. The property owner may be required to install a driveway and culvert to ensure this problem doesn't continue to happen in the future. New tile will also need to be laid.

The second issue is a water problem that started at 211 W. 5th Street. After digging across the street on the Olivet property it was discovered that the 8" Main is plugged. At the present time, it was found that 8-9 homes have water discharge running into that same tile. Will be hooking all tiles on the drop box on 5th Street to tie all the tiles together. All tiles that were found were old clay tiles.

There was no further business. The meeting was adjourned.
