Libby made a motion to allow \$6500.00 for engineering fees to draw up a proposal to get the road project underway, seconded by Jerry Swane, carried. Brandon will forward the engineering contract by email when received.

No mowing bids were received. Brandon Powles gave a verbal bid of \$400.00 per cut. Pam Schilling made a motion to accept the verbal bid from Brandon, seconded by Libby Usera, carried.

The lagoon aerators are plugging up, chemicals will be added when the temperature rises.

Application for service – Tamra is working with Candi Thomson to review the application for service. We should have some recommendations to review by next meeting.

The water restriction sign can be removed now that the well is up and running.

Tamra will schedule the annual street sweeping with Valley Sweeping for the first week in June.
