The Library boasts having a central server employing thin client technology, a 70 inch TV/Video Monitor that is telemedicine enabled, and 16 computer work-stations. A computer lab and conference/lecture hall are operated and maintained by HCVI staff.

The Library provides:

- Access to Information through High Speed Fiber Optic Broadband Internet
- Leading Edge Technology and an Advanced IT Network
- Research Tools
- Educational Resources (such as the WHO online medical library, HINARI)
- Enhanced Communication Platforms
- On Site Medical and IT Training
- Telemedicine and Video Conferencing
- Space for Conferences, Lectures, Individual and Group Study

The Library is supported by a Full Time, University Trained Library and IT Staff.

Free and Open Access is granted to All Health Care Providers (Doctors, Nurses, Students, Trainees, as well as Providers in Other Related Health Care Fields).
