Supporting Figure Skating in the Washington DC (DMV) region

Figure skating in the Washington DC region has a rich and storied history. National (1950, 1989) and World (2003) Championships have been hosted here and the area has served up its share of National, World and Olympic competitors.



A fund was established with the proceeds from these championships as well as generous donations from the endowments of Beverly Kimes, Lydia Paley Hume and Florence Sifferd to support the figure skating community. To date over one million dollars have been granted to individuals, organizations and programs to promote and strengthen figure skating as a sport.

The Capitol Skating Fund is now part of the Washington Figure Skating Club which is the largest figure skating club and one of the oldest in the USFSA. Thus, the tradition of supporting figure skating throughout the entire region (independent of club affiliation) continues with the Capitol Skating Fund committee.

The Capitol Skating Fund

accomplishes this by:

- Encouraging participation and interest in Figure Skating
- Supporting figure skating events such as competitions, exhibitions and seminars
- Assisting higher level skaters (Juvenile and above) with funding for training and skating related expenses
- Supporting organizations and teams connected to figure skating such as synchronized skating and theatre on ice
