

1. How do I take greenery orders?

You can sell door-to-door or ask neighbors, friends, and family via email or text or by posting on social media. Regardless of how you receive the order, you will need to write it down on your paper order form and collect the money and turn both in to the troop.

2. What dates does the sale run?

September 8 to October 28

3. Where does the greenery come from?

Pacific Northwest

4. What day is the greenery delivered?

December 2 – we will have a pickup at the church.

5. How much are the scouts expected to sell? What happens with sales above the minimum amount?

Scouts are required to sell \$400 of greenery. Scouts receive a 10% commission after they sell above \$450. The commission is paid directly to Scouts in cash on December 2.

6. Can we take electronic payments - Venmo or Zelle or Apple Pay? Can we take credit cards?

Yes, but it will be to your personal Venmo, Zelle or Apple Pay and then you will need to write a check to the Troop for that amount. We cannot take credit cards.

7. Do we turn in cash and/or multiple checks or one check for all orders?

It's up to you. You can take checks made out to BSA Troop 599 from buyers; you can turn in cash to the troop; and/or you can write a check from your personal account to cover any cash, Venmo or Zelle you receive.

8. Do we turn our orders and money in weekly or at the end of the sale?

Scouts are encouraged to turn them in as they go. You will turn in your order form and money. The bi-weekly turn-in dates are Sept. 23, Oct. 7, Oct. 14, and Oct. 28. Scouts will receive a raffle ticket for every \$100 they turn in on Sept 23, Oct. 7, and Oct. 14 to be used for a drawing at the meeting each of those nights.

9. Can we take online orders?

Yes, but you will need to write them on the paper order form. We do not have an online order system where someone puts in their payment information, and the online order is automatically submitted.

10. What are the rules for selling door-to-door?

Scouts should only walk around with an adult present. Scouts should be dressed in their Class A uniform and should ensure they look presentable. You should not bring a dog with you. Never enter someone's house. Be respectful if someone says no. Remember, you are representing the Troop at all times when you're in your Scout uniform.
