

Charlotte J. Dutcher 1934 -2004

Charlotte J. Dutcher, age 69 of Pigeon, passed away Wednesday, September 29 at the University of Michigan Medical Center in Ann Arbor.

She was born in Bay Port on November 4, 1934, daughter of the late Victor and Virginia (Hansen) Forman. Following her graduation in 1952 from Bay Port High School, she attended business school in Bay City. On July 21, 1956 she was united in marriage to Donald R. Dutcher in Bay Port. He survives her. Mrs. Dutcher worked for Pigeon Motor Sales for many years, and was office manager for 27 years at Dr. E. Wayne Miller, DVM. She enjoyed sewing, crocheting, and flower gardening, as well as singing with the Sweet Adelines. She especially loved her family and enjoyed her grandchildren.

She was an active member of the First United Methodist Church in Pigeon, where she currently served as a member of the trustees committee, sang in the choir, and was a former church treasurer.
