Cotton Bandage Roll	Bandage Tape
Adhesive Roll (1")	Gauze Pad (3" X 3")
Gauze roll (3")	Q-Tips
Cotton Balls	Scissors (Blunt-nose)
Tweezers	Scalpel
Thermometer	Hydrogen peroxide (3%)
Pepto Bismol	Ear Cleaning Solution
Kaopectate	Dramamine
Aspirin	Gastric tube
Saline Solution	Rubbing Alcohol
Antibiotic Ointment	Latex Gloves
Antiseptic wipes	Triangle bandage
Sting Relief	Instant Ice Pack
Styptic Powder	Emergency Blanket
Plastic Eye Dropper	Tongue Depressor
Milk of Magnesia or Charcoal suspension (to absorb poison)	
Pillowcase to confine pet for treatment and Muzzle/Strips of Cloth
