2018 CCCC Board of Directors Accomplishments

The 2018 Board of Directors is proud of their many accomplishments including:

Increased Communication between Board and individual Members, through surveys, new Member mentoring and frequent email communications.

Updated Club By-laws to clarify contradictory paragraphs, improve readability and enhance scope. Also clearly laid out Board job descriptions and elevated the important Communications Director to appointed Board position. The changes were approved by 98% of voting Members

After much discussion, including at a general Member meeting, we updated and improved Caravan Guidelines. This was done in response to Members concerns, especially regarding safety and NCCC insurance requirements. We also created condensed Caravan bullet point handout.

Developed "Event Request Form" to standardize and improve Run and Event notification. Improved and clarified "How to Plan an Event/Run" handout. The Event procedure allows us to coordinate events and conform to NCCC's 24 hour prior, mailed notification requirement for insurance coverage.

Created Member of Year program, which was developed to enhance Member participation for 2018

Developed new Club Collaterals including New Member Welcome packet, by-fold business and information cards

Included area car club announcements via email, the Club web site and in our monthly Bulletin

Revised Membership roster to include actual Member join date and NCCC membership date

The net result of all of the Board's efforts was to grow the Membership to the highest level in Club history; that is before the turmoil.
