Mayor Masters to host Moroccan delegation June 26-27

Mayor Thomas A. Masters will be hosting a 10-person delegation from the North African Kingdom of Morocco on Sunday and Monday, June 26-27, 2011, at Newcomb Hall at the Municipal Marina.

The delegates from the Consulate General of the Kingdom of Morocco in New York will be visiting the area primarily to provide immigration-related services to natives who live in lower Florida. That “mobile consulate” is the focus of Monday’s gathering, from 10 a.m. to 6 p.m.

On Sunday, Mayor Masters will present a Key to the City and proclamation declaring June 26-27 as “Moroccan Friendship Days” in the City. City officials and the Moroccan delegates will meet-and-greet between 6 and 7 p.m.

Among delegate officials will be Karmoun Mohammed, Consul General of the Moroccan consulate in New York; two vice consuls, Colonel Tarik Garti and Bouziane Khalid; and Dhaidah Taoufik, chief of the identification department. Orlando-based organizer and Moroccan native, Jamila Bradley, will also attend.
