## Fort Worth to fund additional Crestwood Park improvements

For the past two years, the Chesapeake Funds Committee has considered proposals for neighborhood improvements using \$25,000 donated to the association by Chesapeake Energy. One pro-

posal considered was to build a new Crestwood Park entryway and fence. The committee presented the proposal to the City of Fort Worth for approval. The city not only liked our proposals but will make additional improvements using funds the city received from Chesapeake Energy when it leased the city mineral rights for Crestwood Park. The committee's original entry gate proposal was for a wrought iron **CRESTWOOD PARK** sign supported by two stone columns. The City agreed to pay for this entry feature costing \$2,989.

The remainder of the city's Chesapeake funds will be used for a concrete pad surrounding the bike rack, installation of a new bench next to bike racks, metal covers for two existing benches, concrete parking stops, and two secured outdoor electrical plugs.

## CHK fund committee proposals approved

In 2008, the Crestwood Association received a \$25,000 donation from Chesapeake Energy. In 2012, Crestwood Association President Mike Holt appointed a special Chesapeake Funds Committee to seek proposals from the membership for use of the funds and evaluate them.

Charles Miller served as the committee's initial chair. Proposals were to be submitted in written form with sufficient information for the committee to understand the proposals, evaluate implementation feasibility, and determine costs.

The committee was charged with determining which proposals were appropriate and ready to present to the full association membership at a general meeting for final approval.

In the fall of 2013, Archive Committee Chair Kory Cummings succeeded Miller as committee chair with the task of getting the proposals ready for presentation to the membership at the January 11, 2014 annual meeting.

At that meeting, the committee recommended and explained to the members present the following three neighborhood improvement proposals: a neighborhood entry sign **Welcome to CRESTWOOD established 1940**, Crestwood Park improvements totalling \$10,513.00, including a wrought iron, 4-foot high fence to replace the existing post and cable fence, purchase of a new bench, with the city to pay for additional enhancements and a Crestwood Crime Patrol request of \$ 2,200 for recruitment brochures, five additional radios, and funding a neighborhood event.

The total amount requested was \$14,713.

All three proposals passed with substantial majorities.
