PROJECT FEATURES

The Alkali Sink Conservation Bank (Bank) is a 945.79-acre preserve located in western Fresno County adjacent to the California Department of Fish and Wildlife's (CDFW) 11,800-acre Mendota Wildlife Area, the 930-acre CDFW Alkali Sink Ecological Reserve, and just south of the San Joaquin River.

AVAILABLE CREDIT TYPES

The Bank was established in 2016 to provide compensatory mitigation for impacts to special status species and their habitats.

Bank credits available include:

- vernal pool fairy shrimp (Branchinecta lynchi), FT
- longhorn fairy shrimp (Branchinecta longiantenna), FE
- San Joaquin kit fox (Vulpes macrotis mutica), ST, FE
- Swainson's hawk (Buteo swainsoni), ST
- Western burrowing owl (Athene cunicularia), BCC, SSC

The Bank is approved by the United States Fish and Wildlife Service and the California Department of Fish and Wildlife for projects within the service area. Projects outside of the service area may be able to purchase credits on a case-by-case basis.
