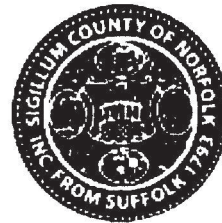


Dear Denise,

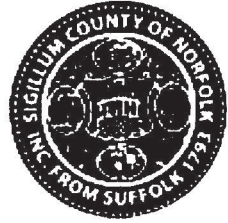
