### Thanks For The King | Sunday Service 11/23/2025



Come and celebrate the joy of our King and offer thanks for his salvific grace and mercy offered to any and all who call on His name.


### You Are Always Welcome Here! Check Out Our Resources!

In the name of total inclusion, we have bulletins available in Spanish. We ask that you only take one if needed so those who are in need can have plenty available.




Several members of our church are participating in the combined choir at this years Community




They will be studying the book
