

Family settles for \$67,000 in suit over death at hayride

A lawsuit stemming from the death of a 15-year-old boy during a hayride accident has been settled for \$67,000.

Kevin L. Altic died Sept. 20, 1986, of injuries suffered when he was run over by a hay wagon during a church hayride.

His parents, Ricky L. and Karen S. Altic, received about \$21,200 each. The youth's sister, Kimberly S. Altic, who was 13 when she witnessed the accident, was awarded \$500.

The law firm of Hall, Ansley, Carmichael and Gardner, which represented the Altics in the wrongful-death suit, received about \$24,400.

The defendants, who did not admit liability in the settlement, were listed as Glidewell Chapel, which has changed its name to Lakeview Lighthouse Church; the pastor, Richard R. Thompson; the chaperones and supervisors, Clara Carter, Velma Stokes, Jenny Hicks, Connie Ducker, Steve Ducker and Betty Lou DeWitt; American Inter-Insurance Exchange and the Aetna Casualty and Surety Co.
