Along with the packing and all of the paperwork of retirement I am thinking about what have I accomplished with the time God has given me in pastoral ministry. There are some areas I am proud of, there are some that I did not get done what I wanted and there were some that just plain fell on the floor and went nowhere. But throughout I tried very hard to follow where God was telling me where to go and what to do.

He gave us four wonderful years as our Pastor, our friend, and our leader in things both spiritual and practical --in the process selflessly devoting inordinate amounts of his precious time to overseeing the post-fire rebirth of Bethany and preaching for us well beyond the expected time if his appointment. Pastor Bill, like anyone who leaves such a position of loving responsibility and dedication to spiritual caretaking, has his thought about his time with us and his hopes and dreams for our future. His parting inspiration from Scripture, given to us as the Leadership Team but applicable to the entire Bethany membership, is the Aaronic Benediction from Numbers 6 – **"The Lord bless you and keep you; The Lord make His face to shine upon you, and be gracious unto you; the Lord lift up His countenance to you, and give you peace."** We each have a calling to follow Christ, as we're appointed priests in His name and under His guidance. Having heard and answered those calls, we have long since become responsible for the ways we answer and act upon them. And that goes on. And on. Thank you, Pastor McNeal, for everything. We'll miss you dearly, but we'll go on. And on. And we'll always remember why.

Bob moved, Jim seconded, and the Team voted unanimously to pursue this, with the idea that the church would support the endeavor to the extent of \$1,000.


Wooden Prayer Crosses....

Trustees Report

The Treasurer has projected we'll need approximately \$20,000 to meet our current expense obligations for May and June. Therefore, \$10,000 was transferred from our investments to the checking account the week of May 10 and has scheduled the other \$10,000 to be transferred the week of June 7.

We continue to plan and prepare for the parsonage changeover from the McNeals to the Allshouse family. The roof and gutters will be replaced by the end of May. Although we don't have a definitive date, Carpetman has assured us the new flooring in the laundry room and one of the bathrooms will be installed prior to the McNeals moving date. Servpro will perform a thorough cleaning, shampoo the carpets, clean the ductwork and perform a disinfectant fogging while the house is empty.

Thank You Note...




