Carl W. Kunstman, 87 of Caseville, died of a heart attack Sunday, Feb. 23 at the home of his daughter in Sterling Heights.

He was born Dec. 7, 1909 in Bay City, son of the late Otto and Caroline (Soehner) Kunstman.

He married Lillian L. Bouck on June 12, 1937 in Redford. The couple lived in Berkeley for 30 years. She preceded him in death on Sept. 15, 1992.
