Some Highlights:

Membership: We operated with about half of our typical revenue for the 2020 season. Membership landed at 171 compared to 312 for the previous year. Twenty eight people who initially paid ended up deferring their membership to 2021. Special thanks to Tracy Dove (Membership) for seamlessly meeting the changing needs of our members.

Finance: The pool is in good shape from a cash standpoint. Although we had a net loss of about \$28,000 for the year, with the help of Tanya Van Pool (2nd Vice President) and Brad Buswell (Treasurer), we applied for and received a small business loan (COVID-19 relief) of \$68,000 for 30 years at 2.75% interest. We will likely need to postpone some of our planned capital improvements, but the club is solvent and in good position going into this year.

Concessions: Steve and Lisa Gross found a way to safely open the Cuda Shack so we could enjoy some treats. As always, we appreciate their commitment.

Activities: For obvious reasons, our social activities were significantly reduced last year, but we did manage to have a "Dive-in Movie" and pizza night. We look forward to a 2021 summer closer to the ones we enjoyed before 2020, but remain committed first to the safety and health of our members.

Swim & Dive Team: Although the Northern Virginia Swim League cancelled its competitive season in 2020, thanks to Amy Downey and Trish Buswell we were able to coordinate a "Swim Conditioning Program" so our Barracudas could continue to develop their skills and enjoy the camaraderie of the swim team. We are looking forward to the 2021 season where we are scheduled to host the All Star Swim Meet once again, assuming it can happen.

Welcome to 2021! Springboard is just a few short months from our planned opening Memorial Day weekend and the excitement is already in the air. Planning for the 2021 season began at the end of last season and we hope 2021 will bring fewer COVID-19 related restrictions and great weather. The membership goal remains to increase our membership and the Springboard family!

After almost 10 years without an increase in membership fees, the Board found it necessary to increase annual dues this season. This is primarily due to the increase in the Virginia minimum wage from \$7.25/hr to \$12.00/hr over the next two years which will have a significant im-



pact on our lifeguard operating costs. Please note the new fee schedule below. The early-bird discount remains available to members who renew and new members who join on or before February 15, 2021. Invoices will be sent by email February 1.
