Good morning, we're all pretty much aware that the world is disjointed from truth and has reversed meanings on words. Reading in Proverbs 11 the word "righteous" is contrasted with the word "wicked." Have you ever heard someone remarking on an item and saying that is '*wicked man*' – implying it is something that is really great? It is a slang word that has been used to amplify the person or happening. (i.e. *wickedly funny*) And of course, the usage of biblical words such as damn and hell; again, used with the idea of something good.

- The world has been desensitized to the reality of eternal damnation.

Isaiah 5:25 Woe unto them that call evil good, and good evil; that put darkness for light, and light for darkness; that put bitter for sweet, and sweet for bitter!

There are plenty of examples of the above verse but we'll not go into them now.

Proverbs 11:10 When it goeth well with the righteous the city rejoiceth: and when the wicked perish there is shouting.

Proverbs 11:11 By the blessing of the upright the city is exalted: but it is overthrown by the mouth of the wicked.

Those are ideal biblical settings and should be the mental and emotional attitude of God's people. Living here we are subjected to underlying principles set in motion by the devil, and we need to keep watch and stay on our God.

I trust you know the world currently is operated by the devil – he is the god of this world and his influence is underscoring politics, religion and the general outlook on life. His chief ways are lying, manipulative, depraved, and damning to hell. A lost person is blind to this truth and in dire need for God's people to live a righteous life.

- Make sure you have Bible principles directing your life.

1^o John 3:7 Little children, let no man deceive you: he that doeth righteousness is righteous, even as he is righteous.

1^o John 3:8 He that committeth sin is of the devil; for the devils sinneth from the beginning. For this purpose the Son of God was manifest, that he might destroy the works of the devil.

Hopefully we'll have the courage and grace to live a life that would be recognized as being a Christian – someone with good speech, uprightness, love for what's right and a fear of doing wrong. Giving Jesus Christ the glory.
