Sara Richmond, 85 of Kissimmee, FL., granddaughter of one of Caseville's pioneer families, died Sunday, Feb. 9 in Florida.

She was born Dec. 5, 1911 in Lake Shore, Maryland, daughter of the late Walter and Mae (Barbour) Sadtler. Her father died in a drowning accident six weeks before she was born. Her mother then married Neil McLean.

She later married Kenneth "Bob" Richmond of Caseville on Sept. 17, 1934. They moved to the Detroit area but returned to the Caseville area in 1954. They then moved to Florida in 1985. He preceded her in death on Feb. 26, 1989.

Surviving are two daughters, Lee (Virginia) Proctor and Peter (Betty) Mosshart; eight grandchildren, Vickie Tipling, Brook Hoge, Beth Hendley, Holly Floyd, Christopher Proctor, Clay Proctor, Laurie Walker and Jeffrey Wurst; 17 great-grandchildren and numerous nieces and nephews.
