PTA Volunteer Opportunities:

Bingo Night: Friday, October 27th from 4-5:30 p.m. Help set up cafeteria for bingo night, food service, review Bingo cards for winners, or breakdown after.

Donuts with Dudes/Dad: September 27 (K-2) and September 28 (3-5). Help serve donuts to our students and their special dudes. Lend a smile!

Book Fair: There are two Scholastic Books Fairs every school year, one in the Fall (October 23-27) and one in the Spring (TBD). Help is needed for all stages of this production. First, we create decorations. Artistic and crafty skills are nice, but all can help! Help is needed on set-up day to transform the Media Center into a literary adventure! Volunteers assist the students as they shop during the fair and help restock the books. On the last day, we pack up all of the books and return the Media Center to its original set-up.

Box Tops: Help our school earn money by clipping and sending in Box Tops! The Box Tops Committee can use your help collecting, organizing, and tracking Box Tops submissions as well as helping with visual displays, online and in-school contests throughout the year, and promoting the Box Top program.

Pink Night: Friday, October 13 from 4:30 - 6:30 p.m. Help ahead of evening. On the day of the event, help is needed for set up in the cafeteria, to assist with food service and vendor support, and for break down afterwards.

Carnival: Friday, November 3 3-7 p.m. Volunteers are needed to assist the PTA with planning and organizing the school's largest event of the year. Subcommittees include Food, Entertainment, Vendor/Hospitality, Classroom Baskets, Carnival Games, Volunteer Management, and Clean-Up. Please indicate which committees you are most interested in when signing up. Must be available for planning meetings throughout the Fall. Will become more time intensive closer to the event.

Holiday Gift Shop (Dec 11-15): Assist in the set-up and operating of Holiday Hut for a two-week period in December. Convert a spare classroom into a holiday shop, display merchandise, and assist students with their purchases.
