

Checklist of Suggested Supplies to Be Provided by The Client for Boarding

(Please keep this checklist for future use)

❖ ALL ITEMS MUST BE CLEARLY LABELED ❖

Item with your scent – e.g. old T-shirt , towel, pillowcase, etc.

Bowls - water & food

Food - Dry &/or Wet (Don't forget *scoop & lid!!!*) - Please provide MORE than you think your dog will need in the event your trip is delayed.

Medication(s) *if applicable*

Treats (For Board-n-Train, please provide an ample amount of 3-5 different healthy, **high-value** treats. For boarding, provide any regular daily snacks.)

Bed (One **must** be provided, as dogs boarding without their own beds tend to seize other dogs' beds.)

Crate (and/or pen) & bedding *if applicable*

Chews – *if applicable* (Required for puppies - must have a large variety e.g., Kong toy, rawhide, bully stick, Nylabone, antler, hoof, horn, etc.)

Non-skid, solid-color mat which is **ONLY** needed I'll be training basic commands (come, sit, down), e.g., yoga mat, bath mat, or kitchen mat (anything solid color, non-skid)

Piddle pads, belly bands, diapers – Only required if applicable (for housetraining or for dogs with urine-marking or bladder control problems)

4'-6' Leash (*Poopie bags are greatly appreciated!*)

Collar or Harness - *dogs & puppies under 25 lbs should have a V-neck harness*

Car restraint - Mandatory for transport, emergency or otherwise (Can be a doggie tote bag, or car harness w/ tether, travel crate – I may be able to provide)

Hairbrush/Comb – *Only necessary if you use one regularly on your dog*

Flea & Heartworm Treatment (*if needed for administration during your absence*) & date of next administration

Completed Application (*only changes & updated information to an application that we have on file are necessary for returning clients*)

Copy of Current Vaccination Records (*a new copy of your dog's vacc. records is required each time you board him/her—always ask for a 2nd copy from your vet.*)

Your itinerary (*and flight schedule when applicable*) **PLEASE INCLUDE THIS. IT REALLY HELPS ME!**

> Note: *If an adequate supply of appropriate, healthy treats, toys, chews, & food is not provided, no problem! These items can be purchased & billed to you.*
