CRITERIA FOR RECOGNITION

Recognition of historical value or aesthetic interest will be based on one or more of these criteria:

- Outstanding architectural design
- Clear example of a particular style, period, building or engineering method; or unique landscape design
- Valued part of the cultural, political, economic or social history of the community/state/nation
- Associated with a noteworthy person, group or event
- Representative of growth and development in the community

Recognition will be determined by the Great Neck Historical Society. It is not a legal designation and does not place any restrictions on the owner.

RECOGNITION PLAQUE & CERTIFICATE

To apply, fill out the application request on the back and mail to the Great Neck Historical Society. We will send you our official application form.

Our committee will review the information you submit and determine if your home, commercial building, institution or significant place is eligible for recognition. After your application is approved you will be asked to send payment. The next step is to decide on the text to be etched on the plaque.

There is no additional charge to receive a **RECOGNITION CERTIFICATE**, which will have a more detailed description of the property.
