## **RGODC RULES and REGULATIONS**

All dogs must be kept on a leash and by their handlers' side. Handlers are always and solely responsible for their dogs' actions. If you are not watching and a fight breaks out, that is your fault and the fault of the other inattentive owner. Pay attention to your dog at all times and follow the guidance of your Instructor. If you do not understand or find something confusing, stop the class and ask. The facility or the class Instructors are NOT to be held liable for injury to any individual or any dog; owners will assume all liability for themselves and their animals. Children are the sole responsibility of their parents and are not allowed on the training field during class sessions unless they are the handler of the dog. Under no circumstances are dogs allowed on the agility equipment at the facility unless under the direct instruction of an Agility Instructor, and RGODC will not be held responsible for injuries occurring in this situation. A trashcan and scooper and/or bags are provided by RGODC, but owners are responsible for cleaning up pet waste in the potty area or accidents which occur on the training field. Any handler or dog found to be excessively disruptive will be asked not to return to class; refunds in such cases will only be given at the discretion of the Instructor.

All dogs must have current vaccinations and proof must be supplied or the dogs will not be admitted into the facility. Tags do NOT constitute proof of vaccination - bring your "rabies slip" or other veterinary written documentation your dog has had his shots. Puppies under three (3) months are too young for rabies vaccination, but must have **two** sets of parvo, distemper, parainfluenza, and adenovirus vaccinations. **Kennel cough (ITB/bordatella) vaccinations are not required, but are highly recommended.** Any dog found to be ill will be excused. Any communicable illness a dog suffers from should be reported to the Instructor for the safety of the whole class. Failure to do so can result in dismissal from the facility. There are no refunds for illness or injury which preclude the completion of classes.

All classes will begin and end promptly as scheduled. It is your responsibility to arrive early enough to potty your dog and prepare for class. Homework is assigned each session and it is expected all homework will be completed before the start of the next class. Classes and training lessons are sequential, so it is important to attend every session. If you miss a class, you must contact your Instructor as soon as possible after the missed class to obtain the homework assignment. Handouts are to be read and followed, and any questions should be addressed to the Instructor at the earliest point in time. Don't let things pile up. Discuss problems promptly with your Instructor. If, after the first class session you decide RGODC is not for you, a full refund will be given upon request. NO refunds will be given after the 2<sup>nd</sup> class, as after that point you have taken a spot which could have been assigned to another person.

All persons registering for classes and paying the appropriate fees will automatically become associate "trainee" members for a period of four (4) months unless they specifically choose to decline said membership. Such members shall be deemed to agree to abide by this club's Constitution and By-Laws and the rules and regulations of the American Kennel Club, and will be eligible to apply for active membership at the end of the trainee membership period.

I do hereby acknowledge I have read and understand the above instructions, and do hereby acknowledge that I am solely responsible for my own behavior as well as that of my dog, and also that the information I have given in both verbal and written form concerning my dog is both accurate and true. I further acknowledge I will not hold the facility, the supporting organization and/or the Instructors as individuals responsible as to my own safety or that of my dog, and acknowledge that neither the facility, supporting organization, nor the Instructors are personally liable for the behavior of any dogs or persons in the class or on the grounds.
