WCTL Rejoice, Refresh, Renew Women's Conference

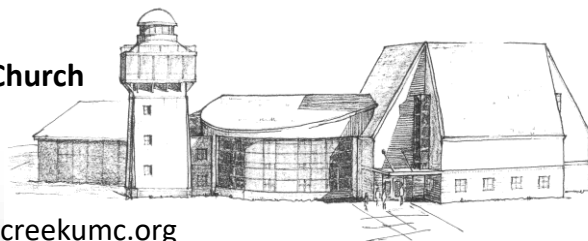
