Sponsors' Hour

It is my pleasure to serve as the Board Representative for Sponsors' Hour. Sponsors' Hour is the time immediately following Send-Off where the sponsors meet in the indoor chapel to pray (aloud or silently) for each pilgrim by name, light their candle, and place their Christ is Counting on You cross on the large cross. These crosses will stay in the Speaker's Prayer Chapel until they are presented to the pilgrims on the last day of the walk. Sponsors' Hour is a meaningful time where we pray not only for each pilgrim, but also for the conference room and support teams.

If you have never chaired an area, Sponsors' Hour is a good one to work on for the first time. The Board Rep will make arrangements for you to get the candles and crosses. It requires you to put labels on the candles, print the program, and be sure the indoor chapel is set up for the ceremony. (Logistics will have the chapel set up, but you will want to check it before the ceremony starts.) If you can only work one time during a weekend, this is <u>the</u> area for you to chair.

A MESSAGE FROM WALK #116 SPIRITUAL DIRECTOR

On my bedside table is a picture of the three crosses at the Camp Alamisco Outdoor Chapel. (Many of you have received this same picture.) In many ways it is a reminder of "God Moments" experienced at that special place. The picture also hides my phone behind it.

The three crosses often remind me of the humanness of Christ and the criminals who were crucified alongside our Lord. The two criminals had two very different responses to Christ. One cursed him. The other one saw so much more. One told Jesus what he should do. The other knew he deserved this harsh punishment. It is on that cross where Jesus took our sin and punishment upon himself.

As we enter into the season of Lent and begin serving on Walks this spring, we are reminded of the cross and the grace which is ours because of it. Our response makes all the difference.
