

BALDWIN SPECIAL TOWN MEETING
JUNE 12, 2018 MINUTES

To Pamela Shea, a resident of the Town of Baldwin, in the County of Cumberland, Maine.

GREETINGS:

In the name of the State of Maine, you are hereby required to notify and warn the inhabitants of the said Town of Baldwin, qualified by law to vote in said town affairs, to assemble at the Town Office, Baldwin in said town on Tuesday, the 12th day of June 2018 at seven o'clock in the evening to act on the following articles to wit.

Article 1. To chose or elect a moderator to preside at said meeting.

Norman Blake was elected to moderate said meeting.

Article 2. To see if the Town will vote to transfer an amount of \$40,000.00 from the Fire Equipment Reserve Account to the Fire Station Reserve Account for the East Baldwin Fire Station Renovation Work.

Fire Chief, Jason Brown explains the need of this renovation. At the March Town Meeting the voters approved to purchase a new fire truck. After ordering the new truck for \$340,000.00 it was decided that they would need to build up the East Baldwin Fire Station in order to house the new truck with an estimated cost of around \$40,000.00.

Article 2 passes in the affirmative.

Article 3. To see if the Town will vote to authorize the expenditure of \$40,000.00 from the Fire Station Reserve Account to spend on the East Baldwin Fire Station Renovation Work.

Article 3 passes in the affirmative.

Article 4. Motion to adjourn at 7:15 p.m.
