Welcome to summer! I can't believe how fast this year is flying by. I have a couple of mid-year reminders for you.

1) Please remember that we do have a Late Pickup policy. We DO charge $\$ 10$ per minute starting at 6:01pm (as written in the Family Handbook). There are always exceptions, for example an emergency such as the base gates being shut. But we do require a phone call. This is out of curtesy to our staff who are here until 6:00pm and are trying to make it home to their own families.
2) Please be aware of any notices next to the sign-in books in your child's classrooms. These contain important information. Oftentimes, we ask for feed-
 back from you, such as whether you are planning on bringing your child back from a fieldtrip or an event. This is to help us plan staffing. If we do not have any children coming back, then we can let our teachers know that they too do not need to come back. But, we do need to know this in advance to make sure we meet our ratios.
