

Year 1 Geography Learning Goal

By the end of Year 1 our children working as young geographers will have demonstrated that they can use effectively a range of simple geographical techniques including basic map and plan work, photograph interpretation and fieldwork together with appropriate geographical enquiry skills and simple subject vocabulary to:

- Recognise, identify and describe some significant physical and human features of their school grounds and its immediate locality;
- Locate where they live within the four nations of the United Kingdom and the countries of the continent of Europe;
- Identify and locate the seven continents and five oceans of the world on a wall map and globe;
- Describe some of the physical and human features typically seen at the seaside and suggest reasons why people enjoy visiting the coast for holidays and how they might take care of the natural environment to be found there;
- Identify, observe and record some of the elements of the weather and describe some ways in which the everyday lives of people in the United Kingdom and at locations around the world are affected by changes in the weather.
