Count Every Legal Vote

US Constitution, Article 2, Section 1

"Each State shall appoint, <u>in such Manner as the Legislature thereof may direct</u>, a Number of Electors, equal to the whole Number of Senators and Representatives to which the State may be entitled in the Congress. ..."

Earlier this year the Governor of Pennsylvania went to his legislature and tried to change their voting laws. The legislature said no. He then went to the Pennsylvania Supreme Court. They said yes. The changes loosened security requirements for mail-in ballots. The new rules: no postmark required, no signature verification required, extend the deadline, and by edict, permission for vote counters to correct ballots with essentially no guidance on how and when to do so.

Furthermore the Pennsylvania Secretary of State issued guidance to counties to canvas late ballots as soon as possible in contradiction to previous direction on this issue from the US Supreme Court.

Clearly the Pennsylvania actions violate the US Constitution. (see the first sentence above)
