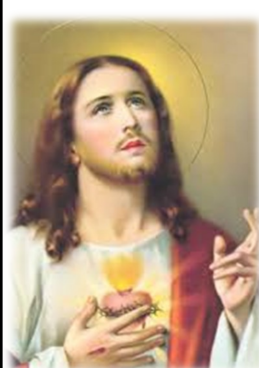

at Easter are now in the narthex.

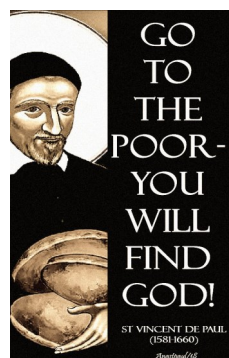


CONSECRATION TO THE SACRED HEART OF JESUS

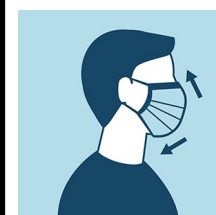
