

Village of Sheridan
Board Meeting
February 9, 2026

The meeting began with the Pledge of Allegiance.

The Board of Trustees met on the above date with the following members present: Dale Green, Judy Hinterlong, Heather Weber, Wendy Greenrod, Dave Heubel, and Marlene Woodward.

Bills for January 2026 in the amount of \$34,118.28 were presented for approval of payment. Dave Heubel motioned to approve payment. Marlene Woodward seconded the motion. All were in favor. Motion Carried.

Minutes from the January 12, 2026 board meeting were presented for approval. Dave Heubel motioned to approve the minutes as presented. Heather Weber seconded the motion. All were in favor. Motion Carried.

Minutes from the February 3 Streets Committee meeting were presented for approval. Judy Hinterlong motioned to approve the minutes as presented. Heather Weber seconded the motion. All were in favor. Motion Carried.

Marlene Woodward gave the January 2026 finance report with an ending balance of \$1,999,503.21. Dave Heubel motioned to approve the finance report as presented. Judy Hinterlong seconded the motion. All were in favor. Motion Carried.

CORRESPONDENCE: Clerk Grimwood stated Jamie Skalic stopped by the office and feels SURF will be reimbursing him soon. He thanked the board for assistance. She mentioned our next e-waste would be Saturday, February 14th by Village Hall. She read a letter submitted by Robert Rowe Library patrons. Beth Wood, librarian, also elaborated on the letter. She thanked Judy Hinterlong for all she has done with library programs.

MAYORS REPORT: None

COMMITTEE REPORTS

Wendy Greenrod, Sewer Committee, would like to see a permit issued every time a utility is digging in the village right-of-way. There has been no word back yet on the village hall clean out.

Dale Green, Police Committee, gave the police report for January 2026. Marlene Woodward motioned to approve the police report as read. Judy Hinterlong seconded the motion. All were in favor. Motion Carried. Dale has also received many positive comments regarding police interactions with the grade school students. There will be another police lunch on Wednesday for student of the month.

Judy Hinterlong, Parks Committee, has been working with the library on another project painting skates. She has been approached by Sheridan Grade School regarding school picnic lunch for the last day of school on May 28th. She asked for volunteers to assist.

Dave Heubel, Zoning Committee, had no permits issued in January 2026.

Heather Weber, Streets Committee, spoke on the Streets Committee meeting. There will be letters sent out to several regarding no parking issues. She will be going out to review areas for further stop/yield signs in town. She also wanted to thank maintenance for their hard work on the maintenance building organization.

OLD BUSINESS

The board reviewed Chapter 15 of the Municipal Code Book with no revisions.

Dale Green had a few more options brought to him regarding leaf burning. He has reached out to Stewart Farm, who would take them for \$8.00/yard. He also contemplated adding a Referendum to the next election ballot on banning. Chief Bergeron noted the Health Department recommended not to burn leaves. Mike Fuller, Village Attorney, also suggested placing dumpsters at the maintenance building for residents to dump leaves. Additional cameras in the area were also discussed. Dale will reach out for further information on dumpsters and report back to the board.

NEW BUSINESS

Judy Hinterlong has been looking into painting the gazebo this year. She mentioned being given a \$3,000.00 quote for paint purchase from maintenance. She also received a quote from a contractor for \$1,600.00 to paint. Mike Fuller showed concerns about insurance which Judy will check with him on this and report back. She was also told that we needed to remove and replace all mulch in the park. She received a bid for \$15,600.00 to remove all and \$11,460.00 to replace. She also has been checking into doing this ourselves and renting equipment. Mayor Wehner will make a few calls regarding total replacement of mulch.

Judy Hinterlong requested to purchase banners for the 250th celebration this year. She obtained a quote for 18 banners and brackets for a cost of \$2,231.72. Heather will check to see if we already have brackets for these. Wendy Greenrod added an alternate plan to this by having an "America Gives" cookout with donations to local entities of \$250.00. Marlene Woodward added maybe we could consider incorporating both. This will be tabled to next month.

Mayor Wehner introduced an Ordinance Amending Chapter 3-Village Employees Establishing a Position of Building Inspector as a Part Time Village Employee. Discussion was held regarding new state certification requirements and questions submitted to IML regarding adding the building inspector as an employee. This Ordinance will be tabled until further information is received.

Mayor Wehner introduced an Ordinance Amending Chapter 27-Public Parks and Public Ways as to Rights-of-Way Applications and Fees. Judy Hinterlong motioned to approve Ordinance 2026-02, changing the right-of-way fee to \$300.00. Marlene Woodward seconded the motion. All were in favor. Motion Carried.

Mayor Wehner introduced an Ordinance Declaring Indexed Developer Contributions. A ROLL CALL vote was taken to approve Ordinance 2026-03.
