# Tournament Rules

Entry Requirements: This is a doubles team bowling tournament operated by the Ohio High School Bowling Program through the Youth Bowler's Tournament Association. This tournament is open to any 2020-2021 7th-12th grade Ohio student. A 9th-12th grade bowler does NOT have to be a member of a high school bowling team to participate in this tournament. Maximum number of teams per squad: 132.

Tournament Organization: These Championships will be conducted on Saturdy, April 24, 2021 at Wayne Webb's Columbus Bowl, 3224 South High St., Columbus, OH 43207. There will be 2 squads allowing for multiple participation. See the tournament schedule (pg. 4) for squad times. There will be 4 separate divisions: A) a 9 th-12th grade boys division, B) a 9 th-12th grade girls division, $C$ ) a 9 th-12th grade mixed division, $D$ ) a 7 th- 8 th grade division consisting of boys, girls, or mixed teams. A 7 th-8th grade bowler may partner with a 9 th- 12 th grade bowler but will be placed in the appropriate 9 th-12th grade division. A bowler may team with any partner in any grade from the same or different Ohio school but may not bowl with the same partner twice. A bowler may bowl in both squads, if desired. Each entry requires a separate entry fee. Walk-in's accepted subject to lane availability.
Tournament Format: All teams in each division will bowl ten (10) games of Baker-format bowling, with an entire team game bowled on the same lane, switching lanes on their pair after each game, and with the team moving pairs after every two (2) games. Bowlers may choose their line-up (order of bowling) prior to the start of any game with one team member bowling the odd numbered frames $(1,3,5,7,9)$ and the other team member bowling the even numbered frames $(2,4,6,8,10)$ in a game. There will be no step-ladder or final elimination rounds. All scoring will be conducted on a scratch (actual) basis.

Team Entry Fee: $\$ 90.00$. Breakdown: Expenses: lineage, staffing, publicity, awards: $\$ 60.00$. Scholarships: $\$ 30.00$. NOTE: The Ohio H.S. Bowling Program will ADD $\$ 30.00$ per team to the total SMART \$cholarships awarded at this Event!

Walk-in team entry fee: add $\$ 10.00$ late registration team fee (not charged for bowlers from 1st shift who decide on-site to bowl the 2nd shift). The closing date for entries is the date of bowling. 100\% of all collected scholarship funds will be awarded and sent to the USBC SMART Program for management/dispersal. Account \#11600.

## An all-day spectator admission fee of $\$ 6.00$ will be charged. Children age 6 and under, no charge. The proceeds from this tournament go to the Ohio High School Bowling Program.

Awards: The 1st place team in each division will receive medals. No fewer than 1:6 teams in each division will be awarded SMART scholarships with $50 \%$ of the team scholarship awarded to each team member. Final results will be posted on OHSB.ORG

Dress Code/Behavior: A sleeved shirt is required. Dress pants or walking shorts for boys or girls are allowed. Shorts/skirts subject to "fingertip-length" standards. No jeans, pants with outside pockets, or hats allowed. Bowlers are expected to be professional in appearance, reflecting the high caliber of tournament bowling anticipated. Abuse of equipment, foul or disruptive language/gestures, and/or unprofessional behavior by bowlers or spectators are cause for the non-refundable dismissal from participation or attendance. All bowling equipment must meet USBC specifications. The use of powder, rosin bags, or any foreign substance (including Easy Slide) on shoes, the approach, the facility floor, or on bowling balls is not permitted. Only participating bowlers and officials are permitted in the bowling area.
Empowerment: The Tournament Manager has the right to refuse any entry and authority to make changes, as necessary. The bowler, by voluntary participation in this tournament, acquiesces to the final authority of the Tournament Manager to make on-site changes and nterpret and enforce all tournament rules, regulations, and procedures. Any unforeseen or not described situation will be regulated by USBC rules with interpretive judgment guided by the best interests of youth bowling and this event.
