Come, join us in welcoming him, as we worship together, followed by a liaht lunch of make-your-ownsandwich with cake for dessert.


Pastor Jason's installation date is scheduled Sunday, June 22. Watch for more details of this special event in the June Community Call and upcoming email and church announcements.

#### JULY 20 -25, 2025 BUENA VISTA UNIVERSITY STORM LAKE, IA

Synod School is a learning and personal enrichment experience for people of all ages. We seek to create an environment of hospitality, healing, and hope. The week is designed for laity, clergy, individuals and families with classes and activities for adults, youth, and children People come from all over the country with their friends and families to share in this week of worship, study, play, and life together. It is an opportunity to learn something new, to continue conversations begun by key speakers with others over meals or a board game, to share talents of creativity and music, to worship without being in charge, to be energized for service, and to enjoy not having to cook for a week.

Many of us carry perceptions of what "normal" is, without ever really guestioning or examining them. Ann McKibben-Dana notes, "the 'myths of normal' permeate almost every aspect of human experience— not just in mental health, but also in race, gender and gender identity, sexual orientation, class, disability, nationality, religion, and more." These myths don't really serve us well, or fit every individual, family or community. Both Mary Ann and Liz Theoharris, our worship leader, will explore how our personal experiences of hope might expand as we let go, or reform, our understanding of "normal" in today's world.

They have dormitories for the students to stay in during the week, so that they don't have to walk miles to and from school every day. Last month the boys' dorm burned down. The students were evacuated with only minor injuries, but one of the neighbors, who was helping to fight the fire, lost his life. We would like to contribute about 1/5th of the funds needed, or \$2,000. Please prayerfully consider helping these students have beds to sleep in again, instead of classrooms and hallways.
